Therefore, review of applicants will be competitive, and all applicants are not guaranteed a position.

Applications are due by **December 1**. Application materials include:

- ☐ A current resume or curriculum vitae (CV)
- ☐ 500-word statement of intent describing your interest in becoming a student delegate, proposed involvement in an established student initiative or initiatives for the coming year, and previous AASP service experience or other leadership experiences (including but not limited to planning of regional conferences or program positions). Not having leadership experience is not a disqualifier for the role.
