# CALL FOR JUNIOR ASSOCIATE EDITOR (1 position)

The Journal for Advancing Sport Psychology in Research (JASPR) is seeking applications of interest for Junior Associate Editor. JASPR's mission is to expand the field of psychology in the domains of sport, exercise, and performance by publishing rigorous scholarship for students, academics, researchers, and applied practitioners. Specifically, JASPR provides students and early-career professionals aspiring to develop their scholarship skills with innovative opportunities to participate as authors, reviewers, and editorial board members within a mentored publishing infrastructure.

# **Primary Function**

- Work, in partnership, with the Associate Editor.
- Promote the growth and visibility of JASPR.
- Navigate the manuscript review process using the automated file management system, Scholastica.
- Conduct manuscript reviews and determine best course of action in collaboration with the Associate Editor.
- Select and invite professionals and students with content knowledge and working expertise to review
  manuscripts in collaboration with the Associate Editor.
- Collate manuscript reviews from all reviewers of a manuscript.
- Using peer review evaluations, along with their own, make recommendations in collaboration with the Associate Editor to the Editor-in-Chief and the Junior Editor-in-Chief of a manuscript's suitability for publication.
- Identify outstanding reviews and create the Reviewer Thank You Letters in collaboration with the Associate Editor
- Attend Editorial Board meetings (virtual, monthly).
- Establish clear, consistent lines of communication with Editorial Board members and manuscript reviewers.

## Qualifications

- Master's degree (or close to graduation) in psychology of sport, exercise, performance, or related area.
- Current AASP student membership.
- Student in good standing.
- Thorough understanding of AASP and APA ethical codes and guidelines.

#### Required Skills

- Exceptional attention to detail.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Professional.
- Punctual.
- Reliable.
- Ability to make difficult and decisive decisions.
- Demonstrated leadership and management skills.
- Sound understanding of JASPR's vision, mission, and scope.

### **Preferred Experience**

- Experience on the Editorial Board of a peer-reviewed journal.
- Demonstrated expertise in research and practice of psychology of sport, exercise, and performance.
- Skills in advanced quantitative research designs and analyses.

- Cover letter (2-page max) of qualifications, skills, experiences, and interest/motivation for the position.
- A letter of recommendation from a faculty mentor/advisor who can speak to the applicant's skills and qualifications.
