CALL FOR JUNIOR EDITORIAL BOARD REVIEWERS (2 positions)

The *Journal for Advancing Sport Psychology in Research (JASPR)* is seeking applications of interest for Junior Editorial Board Reviewer. *JASPR*'s mission is to expand the field of psychology in the domains of sport, exercise, and performance by publishing rigorous scholarship for students, academics, researchers, and applied practitioners. Specifically, *JASPR* provides students and early-career professionals aspiring to develop their scholarship skills with innovative opportunities to participate as authors, reviewers, and editorial board members within a mentored publishing infrastructure.

Primary Function

- Work with the Associate Editor and Junior Associate Editors.
- Complete rigorous manuscript reviews by the provided deadline. Manuscript reviews are assigned based on the Editorial Board Reviewer's content- and methodological-specific knowledge.
- Make recommendation(s) for a manuscript's suitability for publication at *JASPR*.
- Upon completion of the review, communicate the recommendation to the assigned Associate Editor and the Junior Associate Editor.
- Attend Editorial Board meetings (virtual, monthly).
- Establish clear, consistent lines of communication with Editorial Board members.

Qualifications

- University student working towards a Master's or Doctoral degree with experience of the topic area.
- Current AASP student membership.
- Student in good standing.
- Thorough understanding of AASP and APA ethical codes and guidelines.

Required Skills

- Exceptional attention to detail.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Professional.
- Punctual.
- Reliable.
- Ability to make difficult and decisive decisions.
- Demonstrated leadership and management skills.
- Sound understanding of *JASPR*'s vision, mission, and scope.

Preferred Experience

- Experience on the Editorial Board of a peer-reviewed journal.
- Demonstrated expertise in research and practice of psychology of sport, exercise, and performance.
- Skills in advanced quantitative research designs and analyses

Applications of Interest Must Include

- Cover letter (2-page max) of qualifications, skills, experiences, and interest/motivation for the position.
- CV
- A writing sample formatted according to the APA 7th Edition Publication Manual.

Time Commitment

- Weekly time commitment variable depending on submission volume. Each individual review will be due to the Associate Editor and the Junior Associate Editor within 3 weeks of accepting the assignment.
- Term starts immediately and ends on December 31, 2026.
