

## AASP Fellow Application Information

### Criteria to Become a Fellow:

Deadline: March 1 each year

- Demonstrated high standards of professional development by committing directly to the goals and long-range activities of the Association for Applied Sport Psychology (AASP). Commitment is demonstrated through activities including, but not limited to, presentations at AASP conferences, membership on AASP committees, contributions to AASP publications, or holding active CMPC status.
- Distinguished themselves through significant contributions to academic and professional practice knowledge in sport and performance psychology as evidenced by two or more of the following:
  - A distinguished record of academic and/or applied scholarship
  - Outstanding contributions to professional practice in sport and other performance domains
  - A distinguished record of service to AASP
  - A record of sustained excellence in sport psychology teaching and mentorship.
- A graduate degree (doctorate or masters) from an accredited institution in a field related to sport psychology
- Been a professional member of the Association for at least five consecutive years.
- Attended an AASP conference within the last three years (in person or virtually).

*(Constitution Article IV Section 3)*

### Fellow Application Guidelines:

We encourage members to nominate others for Fellow status or to nominate themselves if they believe they are qualified for this distinction.

- Complete the application form.
- Submit the candidate's curriculum vitae.
- Include two letters of reference, at least one should be completed by a current Fellow. Current members of the Fellows Review Committee cannot write reference letters.
